SPCUG is a Microsoft Registered Refurbisher. In the last 12 years we have refurbished and provided over 1200 computers to local civic and social-service organizations for distribution to qualified recipients who need but cannot afford a computer. As of August 2023, we only refurbish laptop computers.

The Sequim PC Users Group is a 501 (c)(3) organization. We are supported by member dues, donations of computer hardware from businesses and individuals and monetary donations. Annual dues is \$30.00 which covers membership for the member and immediate family.

General meetings are held on the 2nd Saturday of each month at 10 AM online via Jitsi. SPCUG Tech Cafe meetings are held on alternating Mondays from 9-11:00 AM online via Jitsi.

Our members maintain the computers at the Sequim Shipley Center. SPCUG volunteers hold a computer help clinic for Shipley Center and SPCUG members at the Shipley Center on Mondays from 1-3:00PM.
